



**24 September - 7 October 1984 Canada**

**(New Brunswick, Ontario and Manitoba)**

**Queen Elizabeth II and Prince Philip in 1984 - Ontario's bicentennial year. The first of these occurred at mid week at Fort Wellington in Prescott and saw a new record turnout of seventy-five troops and twenty-five followers, including a battalion 3 pounder brass 'Grasshopper' Gun and 4.2" 'Cohorn' flatbed mortar. Regimental members were deeply honoured when Her Majesty rose to greet the Colours during a formal march past. Prince Philip accompanies Queen Elizabeth to several towns in New Brunswick and Ontario marking the bicentennial of the provinces. Her Royal Highness travels on her own to Manitoba, her first time in the province since 1970. The Queen's entire visit lasts almost two weeks.**
